For the duration of the Siskiyou Promise program currently offering full enrollment funding and a \$200 book voucher to all new COS enrollees who are 2018 graduates of Siskiyou County high schools, the Scott Valley Bank scholarship will be formatted as follows: The Scott Valley Bank program will fund books in excess of the \$200 Siskiyou Promise allowance for 4 semesters to one full-time student at COS. Following the recipient's successful completion of two years of study at College of the Siskiyous, Scott Valley Bank will award the recipient a stipend in the amount of \$2,500 to apply toward enrollment at a 4-year college or university. The stipend is contingent upon proof of the recipient's enrollment at a 4-year college or university for the next academic term. Book funds will be distributed to the recipient each semester contingent upon compliance with Scholarship Rules.*

SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS & APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Return this completed application cover sheet along with the following:
 - an official copy of your high school transcript
 - a personal essay (minimum 65 words - maximum 2 pages) describing your interest in business, finance, or financial services. Include a description of how your philosophies have been influenced and developed by your activities, employment (paid or volunteer), and studies. You may also briefly describe extracurricular activities and honors earned.
 - three letters of recommendation or other supporting documents
- A minimum of a B average (3.0 cumulative grade-point average) is required to apply.
- Applicants must reside in and will graduate from high school in the College of the Siskiyous or Shasta College attendance area.

JUDGING AND NOTIFICATION:

All qualifying scholarship applications received by the stated deadline will be evaluated by a review panel selected by Scott Valley Bank. Review and compilation of scores will take place by May 4, 2018. Finalists will be contacted by telephone or email and invited for a personal interview. Other applicants will be thanked for their interest via US Mail.

Recipient will be required to submit a valid tax ID before receiving stipend.

SCHOLARSHIP RULES

- Maintain a full college course load in all semesters at College of the Siskiyous
- Maintain a 3.0 or greater Grade Point Average at College of the Siskiyous
- Follow the Business Administration or Finance curriculum advised by College of the Siskiyous
- Send a copy of your grades to Scott Valley Bank each semester - An official transcript must be provided if requested
- Payment of scholarship is by reimbursement or student may arrange direct billing by the college registrar and bookstore
- Certain items may be excluded from scholarship funding such as: "supplies" such as paper, backpack, and art or other elective class supplies.
